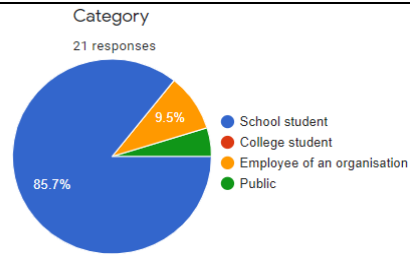

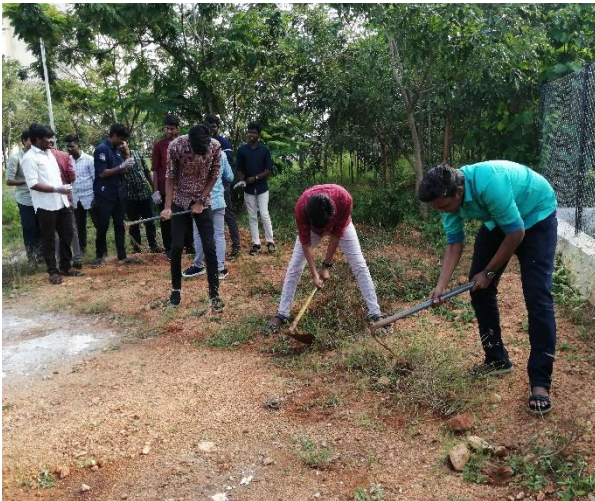
Plantation of high CO₂ absorbing plant sapling (14.12.2021)

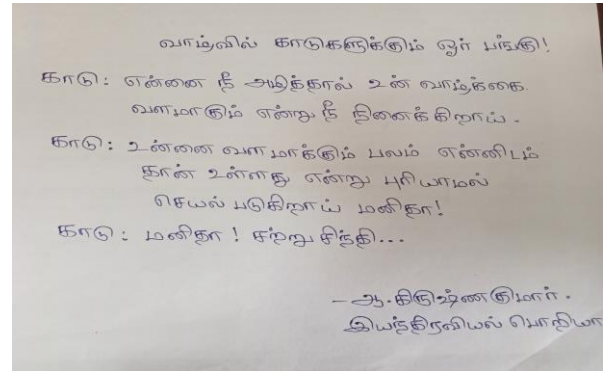
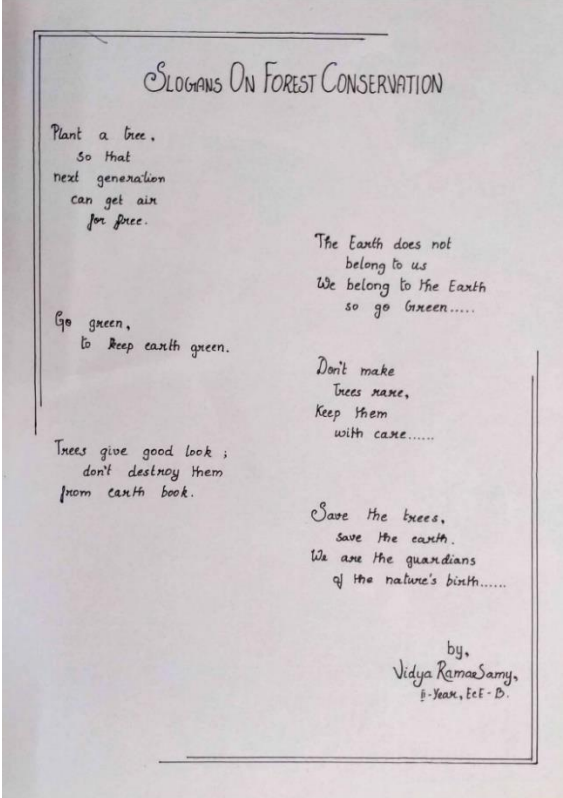
Talk show on swachhta (15.12.2021)

Online competitions on poster making & slogan writing (14.12.2021 – 16.12.2021)

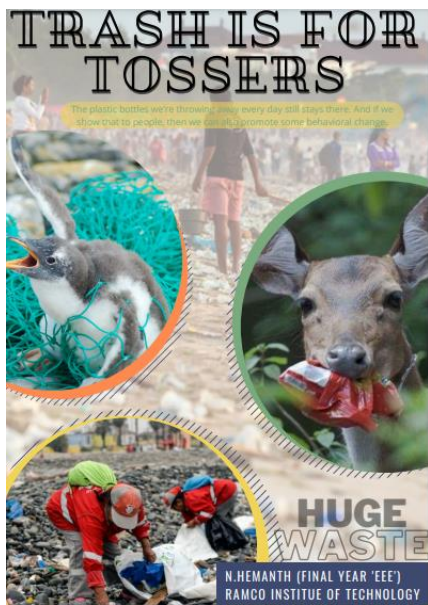

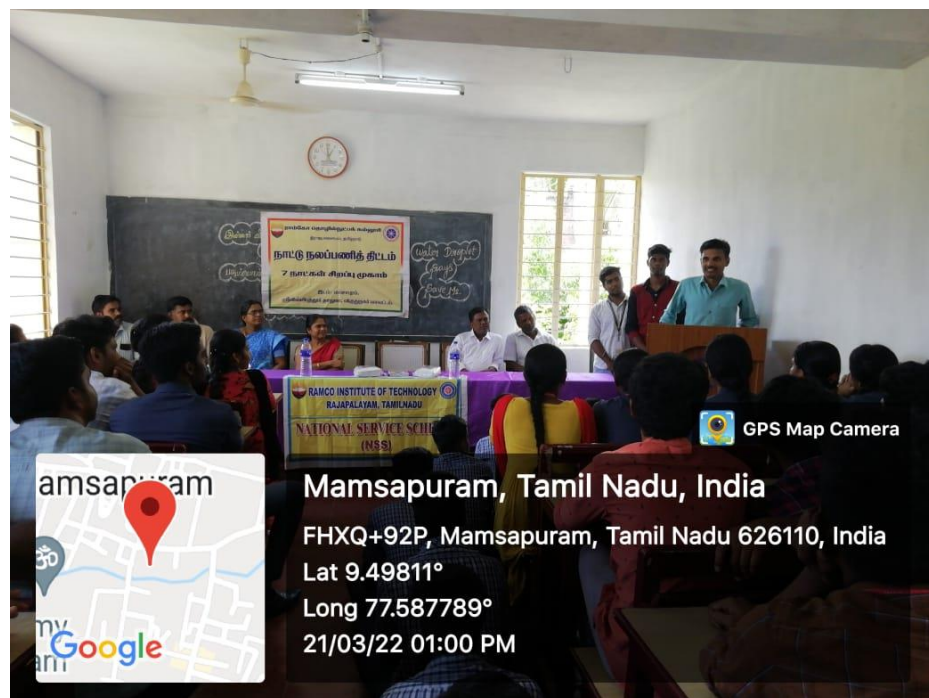

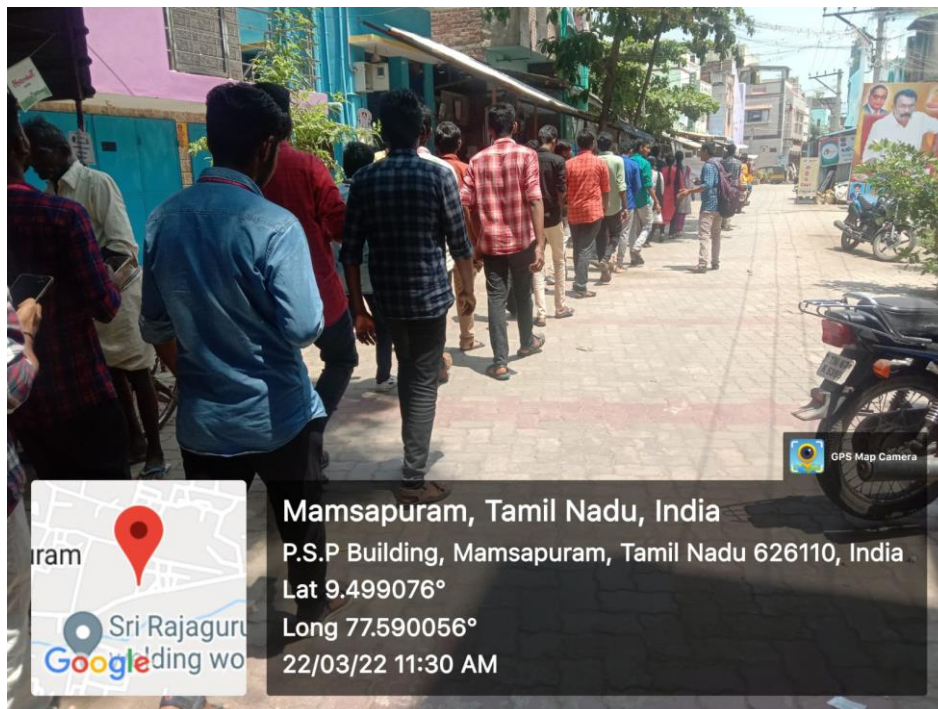
Village Survey (21.3.2022)

Field work (22.3.2022)





Hands-on lessons about organic farming (24.3.2022)

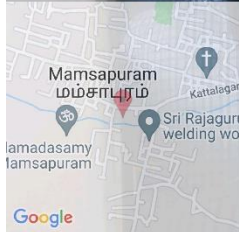
Motivation lecture to the school students (24.3.2022)

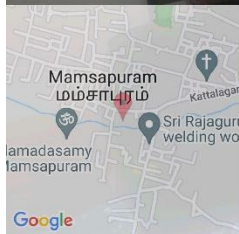


Health & hygiene classes for school students (24.3.2022)

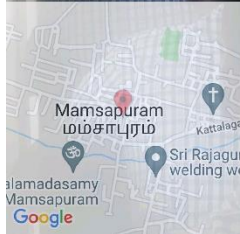

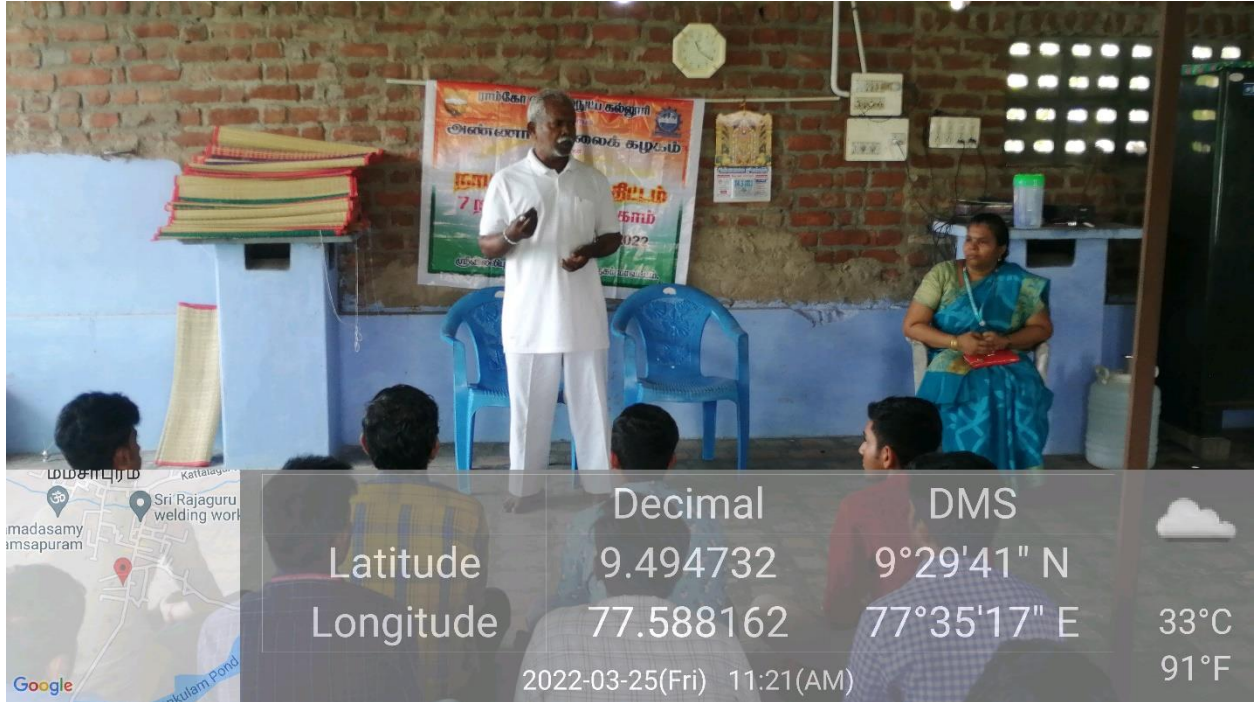
Awareness rally on Road Safety (25.03.2022)

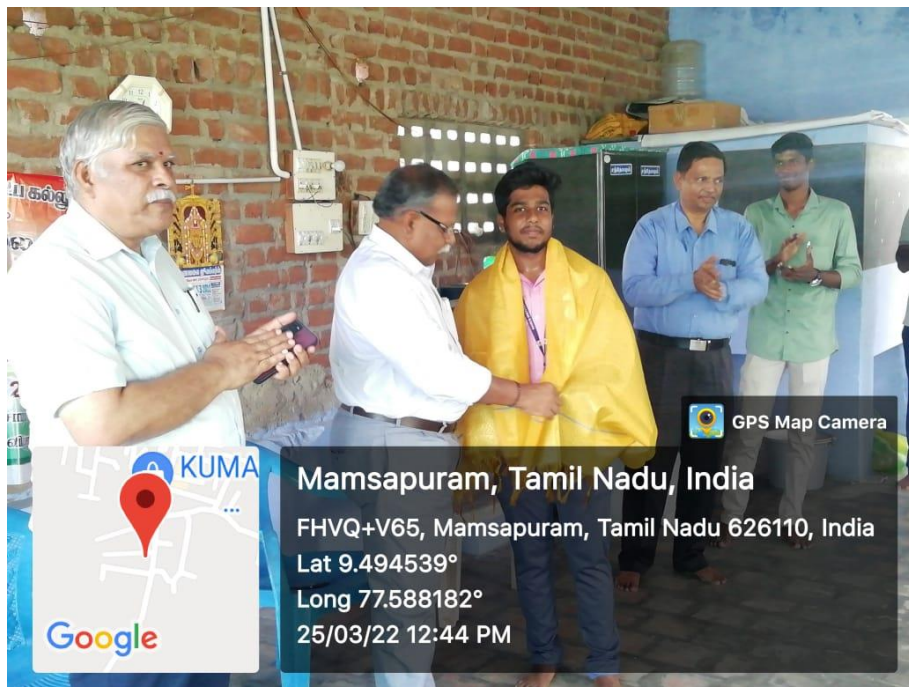


Camp Evaluation (25.3.2022)

The street play practise and rehearsals were held at Mamsapuram's Mahal. officer suggested following the various points during the rehearsal for the successful conduct of the street play.



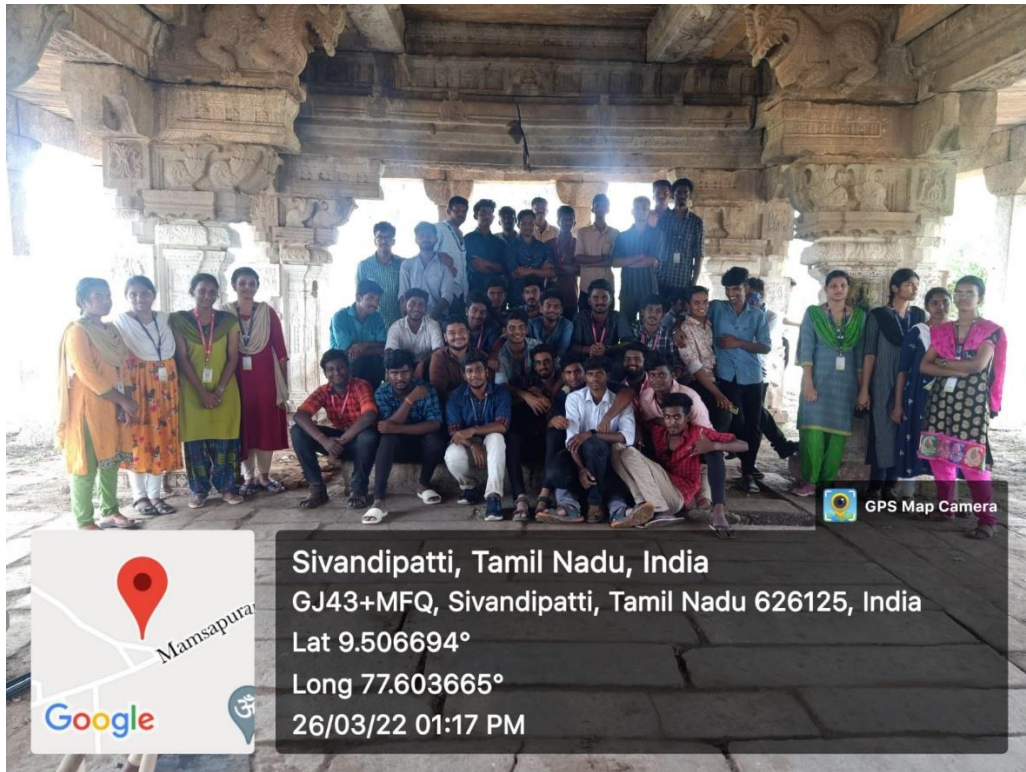
Tree plantation (26.3.2022)

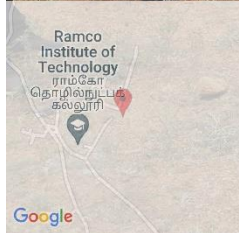
30. Mass Cleaning Campaign

Introduction:

The NCC helps young people develop character, collaboration, a feeling of service, and leadership skills. It also aims to pique the interest of young people in protecting the country by providing service training, and it wants to establish a reserve so that the Armed Forces can expand fast in the event of a national emergency.

The NCC ATC camp was conducted by 5 TN Sig Coy NCC, Rajapalayam, led by Camp Commander, Col. Rohit Gaur.

As a part of NCC, the cadets from Ramco Institute of Technology have conducted the annual training camp for 10 days from May 14 2022 to May 23 2022 under the guidance of Ramco Institute of Technology ANO, Lt R.Aishwarya Devi. This is the camp that was held to help NCC cadets attain their goals. The camp is only for RDC (Annual Republic Day Camp) and TSC applicants (Thal Sainik Camp). This camp also involves a Best Cadet selection process.

The RDC-Annual Republic Day Camp is held at Garrison Parade Ground, Delhi Cantt every year from January 1st to January 29th. Around 2070 selected NCC cadets from all states and union territories attend the camp. The TSC-Thal Sainik Camp is a 12-day camp conducted in Delhi every year in the late autumn, in which the cadets are selected from all 17 directorates by the selection procedure by conducting 3 pre-TSC camps each of 10-12 days in a week interval. 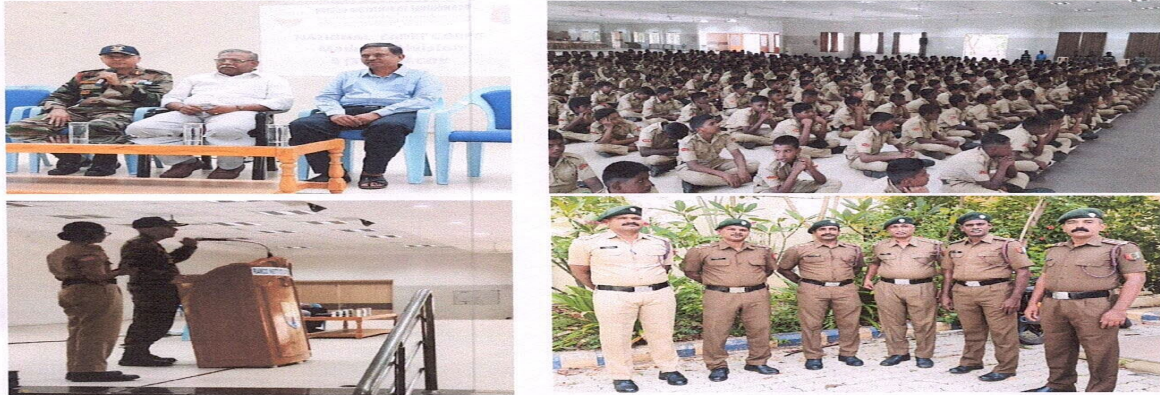


Fig 1: Inaugural Function on 16 May 2022

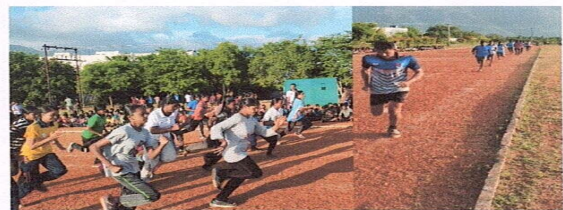


Fig 5: Running Competition
