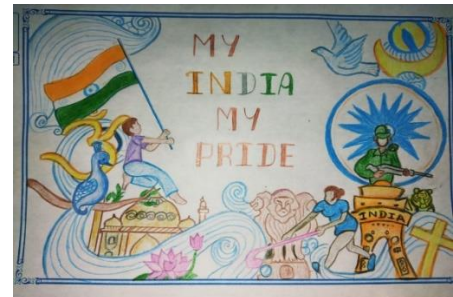
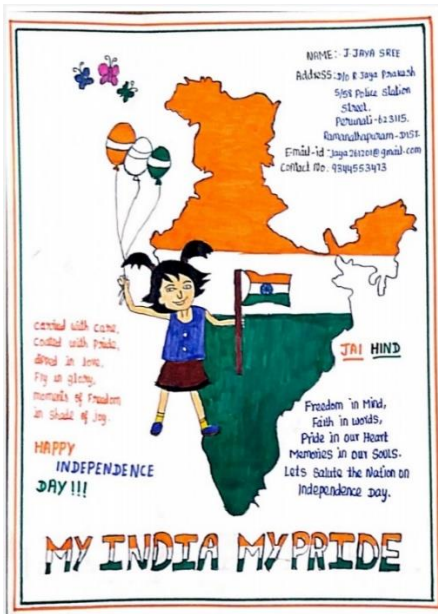
Drawing

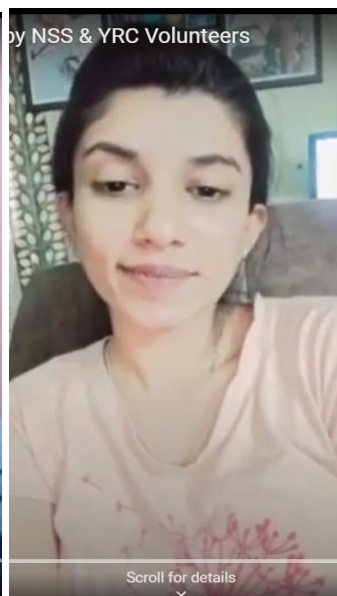

5. SPECIAL CAMP FOR NEW VOTERS REGISTRATION (24.11.2021)

In response to Assistant Election Officer's letter No. A5/4314/2021 dated 09.11.2021, a camp for new voter registration will be conducted on 24.11.2021 at RIT-Civil Seminar Hall. This camp is specially arranged for the students who are residents of Rajapalayam taluk. A printed copy of Form-6 is issued to the eligible students and they are assembled at the seminar hall. Then Dr.P.Thiruramanthan, YRC programme officer, explained the way to fill the registration form and the students filled the form and submitted the same to the taluk office, Rajapalayam, with the necessary documents. Totally, 26 students from the first year filled the form in offline and 64 higher semester students registered their enrollment through the online portal of the Election Commission of Tamil Nadu.

Swachhta pledge taking ceremony (14.12.2021)

Plantation of high CO₂ absorbing plant sapling (14.12.2021)

A tree plantation programme is organized in our college campus as part of this event. 15 students and 10 staff members were involved in this activity, and they planted around 20 saplings of high CO₂ absorbing plants (indigenous varieties like neem, peepal, banyan and *Millettia pinnata*). This programme is jointly conducted with the faculty club of RIT. Mr.T.Ramprakash, AP/Civil coordinated this event.





Cleanliness drive in campus (14.12.2021)

Thirty students were involved in the cleanliness drive in our college's power house. Some students remove the unwanted species with the help of spades. Other students collected the stones and rocks that will be disturbing the free movement of power house workers.



Cleanliness drive hostels

A cleanliness drive was conducted in our college girls' hostel on 14.12.2021. Some of the first students residing in the hostel participated in the event. Students cleaned their rooms by picking up waste materials and arranging their beds neatly. A few more girl students cleaned the common TV room.



Special stress on maintenance of kitchen and food waste management. (14.12.2021)

Five students along with the physical director, Dr.G.Veeramani have visited the hostel kitchen, dining hall, and storeroom. Students explained the importance of health and hygiene during this pandemic situation. Students gave some ideas on how to maintain the kitchen so it is clean and neat. They also gave special attention to the cooks and housekeeping workers. Students also learned about the food waste management mechanism that is followed on our college campus.



Special drive on water conservation

Our college regularly conducts a special drive on water conservation for our students and staff members. As part of the project, our college created a few small ponds on campus. Awareness program to ban on single use plastic (15.12.2021)

As a part of the awareness programme to ban single use plastics, Anirudh Srinivas, I/AI & DS gave a special talk to our first year students. He explained the origin of plastic, the demerits of single use plastic, and its impact on the soil and animals. He gave some innovative ideas to ban single use plastic for their residential areas. Our college campus already has a ban on single-use plastic bottles, particularly in hostels.

A presentation programme on innovative technologies for waste recycling, energy conservation was conducted at the ECE class room on 15.12.2021. In total, six students delivered their views in the form of power point presentations. Around 53 students participated as a part of the audience. 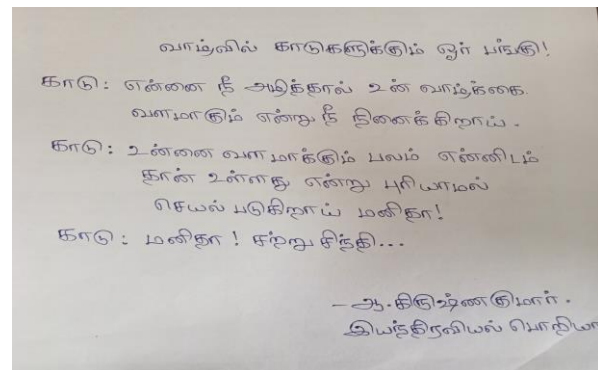
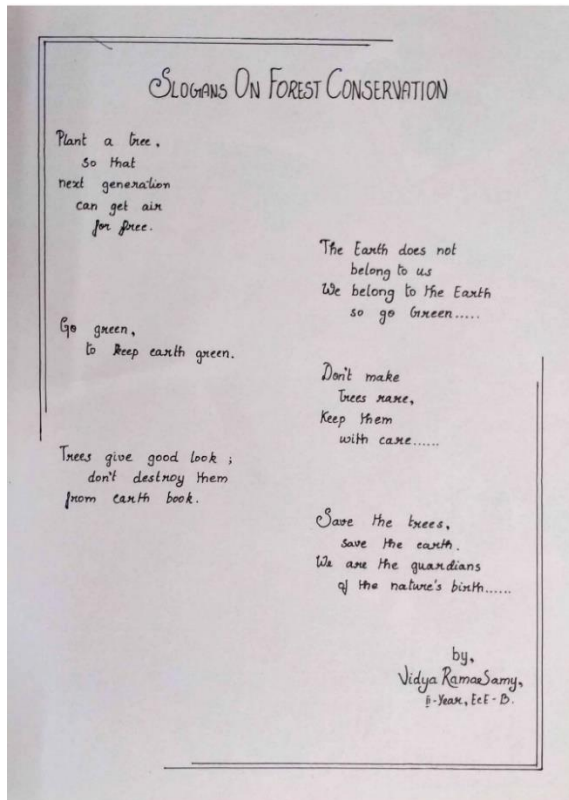
Talk show on swachhta (15.12.2021)
