

7.1.9 Sensitization of students and employees of the Institution to the constitutional obligations: values, rights, duties and responsibilities of citizens

For students and employees, webinars on fundamental rights in constitutional law and their protection are arranged in order to disseminate information about the constitutional obligations, values, rights, duties, and responsibilities. Additionally, during the Student Induction Program, students receive lectures from internal and external guests on human values and traffic awareness. Every year, Republic Day and Independence Day are commemorated with the raising of the flag and special speeches by people in authority to honour the sacrifice of patriots and martyrs and to instill in students a sense of responsibility and duty towards the country. The independence struggle is also highlighted in these programmes, and the importance of the Indian constitution is explained. On such occasions, NCC cadets are also involved to promote discipline and responsibility. Periodically, blood donation drives are held in conjunction with the General Hospital in Rajapalayam, when faculty members and students volunteer to give their blood. For social awareness, several cleaning campaigns are also carried out on campus and in the adjacent villages. Our college's Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) cell sends student volunteers to the adopted villages to run skill-building activities.
