Report of Industrial Visit

The CSE Department Association (RIT-CLUSTRA) arranged an Industrial Visit to "Ramco Systems Ltd-Chennai

The Departments of Computer Science and Engineering, III year students on 06.01.2017 (Saturday) visited **Ramco Systems Ltd-Chennai** and **IIT Madras**. Totally 56 students and 2 faculty member attended

Facilitator: Speaker- Shyamala Jayaraman
(Senior Vice President – ERP)

Mrs. Shyamala Jayaraman gave us an brief introduction about Ramco and technology. She made us understand how the Ramco systems and the group of concerns like other Ramco industries and college works with the help of ramco ERP.

She then gave us a deep knowledge on the Virtual works and how all the employees and people in the ramco systems use Virtual works as a part of their routine job. She also insisted that virtual works play a major and bigger role in code generation. When given the sufficient conditions and interface design, she said that the virtual works automatically generates the entire code from presentation tier to application tier.

She made us understand that the developers and people in Ramco systems visualize more common intersections and replication of code between the presentation and application tier and so it is better and easy to unite both the tiers and bundle them up in one code. She explained this is how the virtual works came into place.

She also explained the evolution and transition of Ramco since 1993 to 2016. The platforms, the areas, the operating systems to the cloud ERP they use now. She said the Enterprise cloud computing platform plays the foundation of all Ramco products and services.

She quoted that it is a model-based, collaborative approach that uses ready-to-use business services, as well as freshly developed business components. She placed a point that the virtual works can help us configure and alter our solution whenever we wish to. Virtual works is a model driven development platform wherein applications are not coded, but composed by using existing or newly created business assets.

At the end of the 15-minute session, when asked a question on "Amongst all such benefits of virtual works, is there really a flaw or disadvantage with the virtual works?"

She replied that yes there are some kind of challenges wherein, once the model or design has been composed, it is very difficult to incorporate extra coding or alterations into the model, as it is an automatic code generation concept and loading in alterations or changes was once a biggest challenge and later they came up with an extension kit along with the virtual works so that the changes can be smoothly fitted in the existing model.

The session on the whole was a breathtaking one with so much of technologies and solutions related to cloud and also Ramco. It was clearly informative and fascinating to know a lot about the Ramco systems which we would never get a chance to learn otherwise. The visit to the company was really a great, informative and interactive one.



Cloud computing

Facilitator: Cloud Computing

Speaker- Chinmoy Rajpal

Principal Consultant – Cloud Provisioning

The session was very interactive. The session started with a question "What is cloud computing?" We came to know that cloud computing is a network with security and it is a model for enabling convenient, on-demand network access to a shared pool of configurable resources like networks, servers, storage, applications and services.

He said that security deals with confidentiality, integrity, availability. Some of the cloud providers were discussed by the session handler and he asked the name of the services provided by those providers. Many members answered those questions. Then the types of clouds (private cloud, public cloud, hybrid cloud, community cloud) were discussed.

He emphasized of importance of VPN (virtual private network) which uses a public network like the internet to connect to a private system. One of the major focuses of VPN is its security, which

usually features some method of encryption for protecting sensitive data. Instead of using a private network like VPN the cloud uses online services by connecting to server, usually provided by a third-party vendor.

He said that, Initial investments into VPNs can be costly, but the cloud is relatively inexpensive. These are the difference we came to know about the VPN and cloud computing. The versatility of the cloud and its more manageable cost are clear reasons for the cloud computing growth in past few years.

Finally the characteristics of the cloud computing was discussed. The session was useful and we were able to gain knowledge on cloud computing.

IIT Madras

The students were given a wonderful opportunity to go to IIT Madras. The campus gave us a visual treat. The students were divided into five different groups where each group was taken to labs like Artificial Intelligence, Network Systems, and VLSI Computer Visions. The students at IIT doing PhD gave a speech to our students about the various projects they were doing. The projects done by them were so innovative and informative and the students were motivated.

In the VLSI lab, the projects based on data analysis and image processing was explained. The problems that occur in railway tracks and ways of recognising them based on the Data they received earlier were all their project areas. Ideas on pursuing internships at IIT were discussed and students asked various questions.

Moving onto the network systems lab, the concepts and ideas behind Internet Of things were explained. The reason for the shift from IPV4 to IPV6 was discussed and the address space limitations in both of these protocols were also discussed. Various projects that the students were doing PhD on were explained and they were so interesting.

Next students were taken to computer visions lab where the modern technology and the implementation process were informed. The camera in smart phones that works based on face recognition system and the way the application identifies the eyes, nose were explained in detail and it was also informed that they work based on C and C++ . The scope in this face recognition field was explained and the session went on for 15 minutes.

The final laboratory was Artificial Intelligence. The difference between artificial intelligence and database were defined .The AI machines could do any sort of practical works but whereas the database is a static box and it just reproduces what it stores .We were informed about the projects the students there were doing were explained.

After visiting, the students gathered together and various questions of proceeding the higher studies and doing the internships at IIT were discussed. The students were thankful to them.
