2. LEGAL AWARENESS PROGRAMME FOR WOMEN EMPOWERMENT

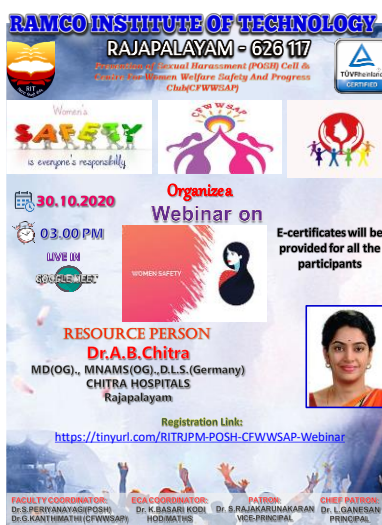

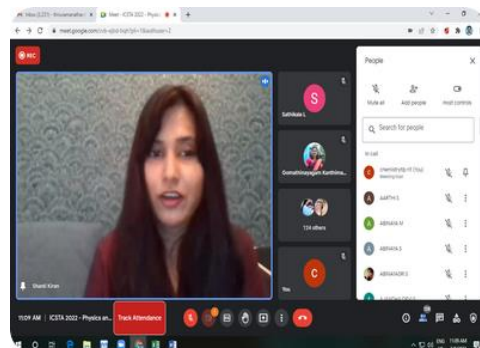
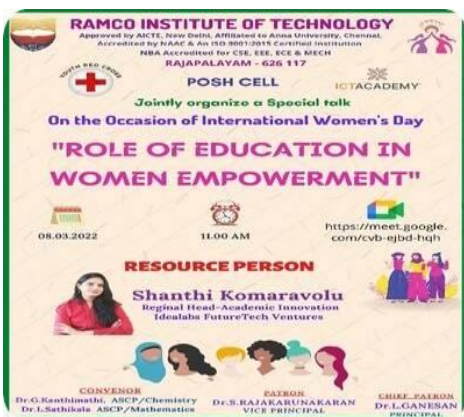
5.Prevention of Sexual Harassment at Work Place
