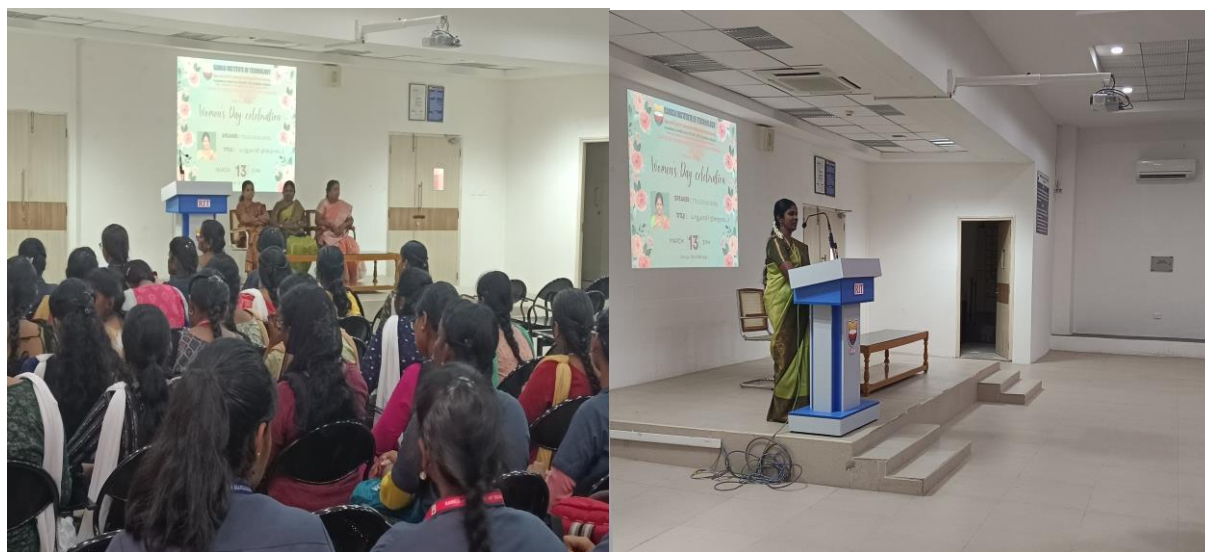

International Women's Day

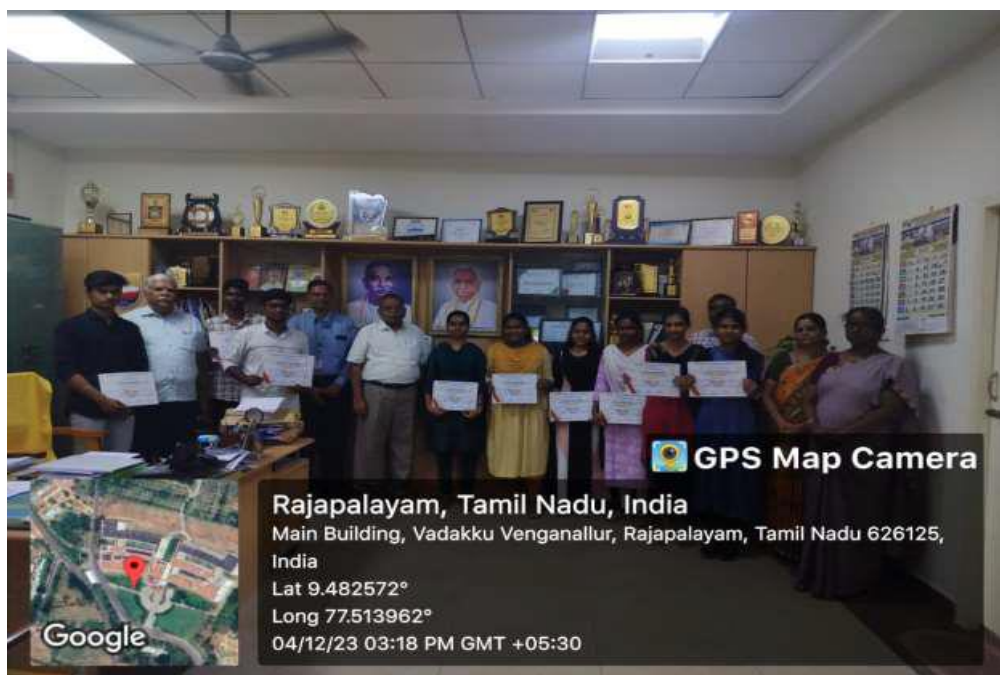
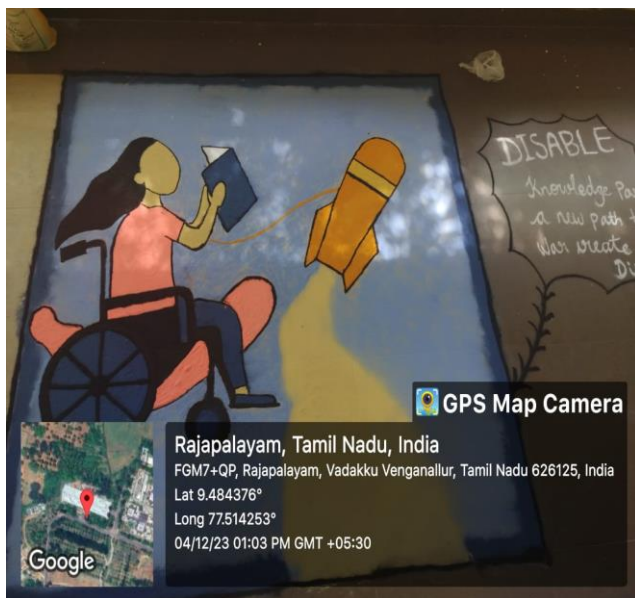

International Day of Persons with Disabilities

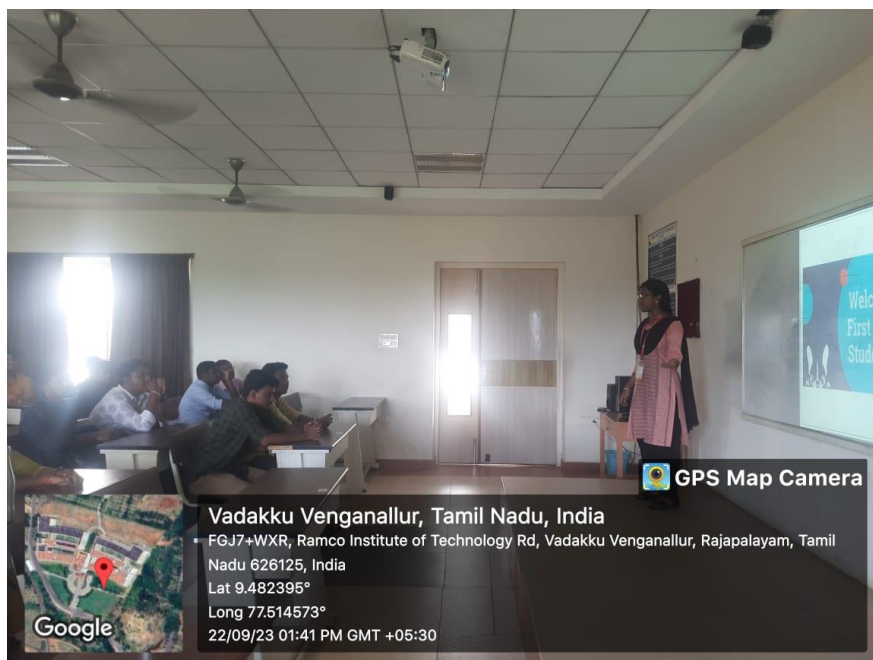

Awareness Programme on Women Safety

The Centre for Women Welfare, Safety and Progress (CFWWSAP) & POSH Cell of our college organized an awareness programme on “Women Safety” on 21.09.2023 for First Year students. The Special invitees are Smt. N. Meena, Sub-Inspector of Police, Cyber Crime, Virudhunagar, Smt. Banumathi, Sub-Inspector of Police (Anti Child Trafficking), Virudhunagar, Smt. Kannathal, Sub-Inspector of Police, Women Police Station, Rajapalayam, Smt.K.Selvi, Case Worker, Social Welfare Department, Smt. R.Muthulakshmi, Outreach Worker, District Child Protection Unit, Virudhunagar, Smt. Christy, Sub Inspector of Police, Women Police Station, Rajapalayam addressed the gathering. The invitees through a very lively address, explained to the students why it’s crucial to recognize and report sexual harassment, abusive behaviours and advised them seek help when needed. They educated the students about how to maintain healthy relationships. They also elaborated on the importance of support systems, such as helplines (181) shelters, and counselling services. They explained how online frauds can pose a significant risk to students who use smartphones and other digital devices. Students are asked to exercise extreme caution while posting photographs on social media. They are also warned against unnecessary downloads of apps. Totally 222 students attended the program and they benefited.
