Objective of the activity:

- It Enhance the listing and communication skills of the students.
- It helps students to build confidence in them.

Activity :

Help each student to explore and discover personal meanings of a topic through interaction with other people. Invite students to address one another and not always “go through” with others. Pause to give students time to reflect on student summaries or others' comments. Asked each leader to present represent the idea of the group and encourage others in the group.

It encourages students to listen more carefully to each other, involves requiring each person to begin by paraphrasing the comments of the previous student or by showing how his or her remarks relate to those of the previous student.
