- **Days of the Week** – Naming and using weekdays in conversations.
- **Frequently Used Words** – Acquiring a functional vocabulary for quick understanding and usage.
- **Self-Introduction** – Practicing how to confidently introduce oneself in Hindi.

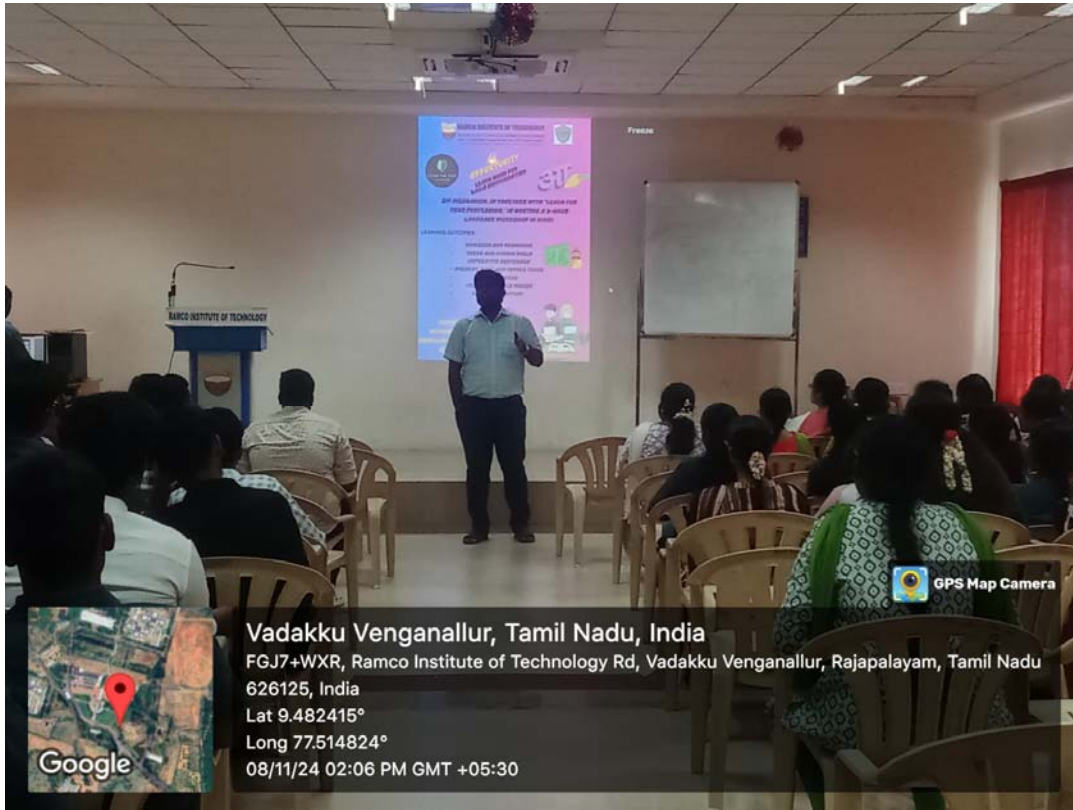
## 16.Impact and Participation
